

COMMITMENT TO FAIR PLAY POLICY

DATE OF POLICY DEVELOPMENT: FEBRUARY 13, 2021

A. BACKGROUND & PURPOSE

The Alpine Ski Association of Yukon policy of Fair Play promotes the principles of respect, responsibility and integrity. The purpose of this document is to clearly inform all Alpine Ski Association of Yukon athletes, coaches, staff and members of the Alpine Ski Association Yukon on the Fair Play policy.

B. RESPECT

The principle of respect is to treat all participants (athletes, coaches, staff and members) with respect at all times. That all participants of Alpine Ski Racing in Yukon are involved in the sport for enjoyment and should not be intimidated from participation in the sport. All participants will respect and play by the Laws of the game as defined and explained by Alpine Ski Association of Yukon, Alpine Canada Alpine and FIS.

C. RESPONSIBILITY

That all participants will act in a responsible and safe manner in any activities sanctioned by the Alpine Ski Association of Yukon.

D. INTEGRITY

All participants are expected to be honest, sincere and honorable in their relationships with other participants. That coaches and officials will promote the value of sport for individuals, teams and society in general and will encourage all participants to continue their involvement in the sport. This policy covers all Alpine Ski Association of Yukon members, coaching staff, administration staff, board members and others associated with the Alpine Ski Association of Yukon operation.

E. REVIEW AND APPROVAL

This policy shall be reviewed by the Alpine Ski Association of Yukon board of directors on a regular basis.
