



ALPINE YUKON

PLAYER CONDUCT POLICY

This policy applies to all athletes who are on the Alpine Yukon team.

- 1) Athletes are expected to conduct themselves in such a way that enhances the reputation of their team, Alpine Yukon and the Yukon Territory.
- 2) Athletes are expected to be courteous to and respect the decisions of the officials, coaches, and managers. Belligerence and lack of respect for these people will not be tolerated.
- 3) Possession or use of alcohol, drugs, or any substance prohibited by law is strictly forbidden.
- 4) Profane language will not be tolerated at any time.
- 5) Fighting and disrespect among team members will not be tolerated.
- 6) Athletes are expected to adhere to curfews set by coaches, and managers.
- 7) Athletes are expected to leave the premises they are occupying in a clean and tidy condition (change rooms, hotel rooms, billet's homes, etc.).
- 8) Athletes will be held responsible for any vandalism, fighting, or public disrespect they display while representing Alpine Yukon.
- 9) Any leisure activity by athletes has to be permitted by the coach or his/her representative while on tournaments or races with Alpine Yukon.
- 10) All team members must travel to and from competitions by the means of transportation designated by Alpine Yukon, unless arrangements are made by the athlete's parents/guardians prior to initial departure.
- 11) Athletes may be allowed in some circumstances to leave the group to visit relatives, but only with written/verbal permission from parents/guardians prior to initial departure.
- 12) Failure to comply with the aforementioned points may result in the suspension of the athlete from Alpine Yukon and the immediate return of the athlete (if on a trip) to their parents at the parents' expense.

Any player named to a Team, participating in any competition, taking part in any approved event or receiving financial assistance from any source on the recommendation of Alpine Yukon, must agree to these rules of the Conduct Policy prior to accepting the assignment or the financial assistance.

If a player desires to appeal any personal application of the rules of the Conduct Policy, an appeal may be filed within 48 hours with the President of the Alpine Yukon. Such an appeal will be immediately investigated and the findings therefrom will be binding.

I, the undersigned, as a participant on a Whitehorse F.C. Premier team, have read the preceding Conduct Policy, and understand that there are expectations of me to conduct myself as outlined in this policy. I agree to abide by the rules and regulations set down by my team, by Alpine Yukon, and by any outside event my team attends. Should I fail to follow these regulations, I realize my conduct shall be reviewed and I may be disciplined, up to and including removal from the Representative team and any outside event.
